



The church sanctuary now has a hearing loop installed. This is a system that sends the audio captured on the microphones directly into a hearing aid worn by anyone in the congregation. The system provides the cleanest, clearest sound imaginable for hearing aid wearers and does not require a headset, as it works with any hearing aid that has a T-coil. We also have a limited supply of loop receivers and headsets that can be used during worship if your hearing aid is not equipped with a t-coil. For assistance during worship, feel free to ask an usher.

If you wear a hearing aid and are unsure if it is equipped with a T-coil, please consult with your audiologist.

Dear FPC Family:

On behalf of the Endowment Committee, I would like to provide the following report for the fiscal year November 1, 2022 through October 31, 2023, as required under the terms of the endowment:

At fiscal year end the total assets of the fund were \$2,091,931. This is down 2.7% from this time last year, due to investment losses. However, we netted better than the US market average of -19.6% following a difficult 2022. Expenses were \$13,192, which consisted mainly of investment fees and our share of the annual audit. Net income for the fund was \$103,520.

Our by-laws state that we can use between 4-5% of the 12-quarter rolling average of \$2,281,269 to calculate the funding available to the Session. The committee decided to use 4.5% of this average, which comes to \$102,657. This funding is available immediately and can only be used for buildings and grounds related projects.

I would like to thank the following committee members for their service over the past year: Bill Malloy (assistant treasurer, ex officio), Kim Brabham (secretary, at-large), Susan Malloy (Registered Investment Advisor, ex officio), Becky Childers, Jennifer Tillman, and John Joyce.

I would also like to thank you, our congregation, for placing your faith in our efforts as we seek to serve God by the actions of this committee.


